

## Walter E. Krueger, D. Mus., FAGO, ChM



Organ recitalist, teacher, lecturer, and hymn festival leader, Walter E. Krueger has also composed a number of sacred works for organ, choir, and instruments. He earned his doctorate in Music History and Organ from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. Dr. Krueger also holds degrees from Concordia University Chicago and the University of Michigan. Over the past 35 years, he has served churches, schools and colleges in California, Michigan, Illinois, and Oregon.

Krueger was recognized as a Fellow of the American Guild of Organists (FAGO) in 2006 and a Choir Master (ChM) in 2007. He recently served the American Guild of Organists as Regional Councillor for the Pacific Northwest, where he regularly visited and communicated with chapters in five states. Krueger is also a Dean Emeritus of the Portland Oregon Chapter.

A Lutheran church musician and music educator in the Portland area, Krueger is also an adjunct professor at Concordia University, Portland.
